Dear Administrator:

This letter provides you with information regarding the *revision* of the Nursing Homes cost report submission due date as stated in the Dear Administrator Letter of May 28, 2019. The 2018 cost report and applicable electronic certifications are now due to the Department by **Monday July 29, 2019**. The 2018 software is now available through the internet-based Health Commerce System (HCS).

The Cost Report Software includes a new schedule: PART I – Prefatory Data – **Community Living for New Yorkers Living with Physical Disabilities** to provide information on efforts made to prepare residents to return to the community. The new schedule includes questions on:

- Functional capacity assessment;
- Interest in information on returning to the community; and
- Prep and orientation to residents for safe and orderly discharge from the facility

Completion of this schedule is required. Please find attached a copy of the schedule. No other changes have been made to the software.
