
Managed Care Policy and Planning Meeting

MLTC Month in Review

- **Phase II of NHTD/TBI Waiver Transition into Managed Care**
 - A Waiver Transition Stakeholder Workgroup meeting was held on March 1st
 - DOH addressed a letter from the Alliance of TBI & NHTD Waiver Providers with a status updates on outstanding issues and next steps for the transition

Current MLTC Statewide Enrollment*




Conflict-Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) Activity

Cumulative Activities: Since Program Inception

- 167 Nurses on Staff (*as of January 31st*)
- 559,772 Incoming calls
- 158,569 Notices mailed
- 169,163 Total appointment requests

Highest Demand for Evaluations: Top Three Counties

1 st :	NYC	125,040	74%
2 nd	Nassau	7,971	5%
3 rd	Suffolk	6,717	4%

Fully Integrated Duals Advantage (FIDA) Update

- **Region 2 Expansion**

- The first Region 2 plan, Agewell, is operational in Suffolk and Westchester counties
- Additional plans will be approved this spring and will open on a rolling basis
- Region 2 advertising forthcoming

- **Future of FIDA Stakeholder Meetings**

- Suggestions for policy changes were submitted and discussed during the February 17th call; DOH and CMS are reviewing internally and will deliver policy decisions in the next several weeks
- Public stakeholder meetings about the future of integrated care for New York are still being scheduled; details forthcoming

CFCO Update

- Sub-workgroups for **Provider Management**, **Benefit Management** and **Clinical Management** have been convening over the past two months:
 - Groups are finalizing deliverables and meeting minutes, which DOH will distribute
 - The Division is working on compiling FAQs as a result of recent discussions and submissions to the CFCO BML
 - FFS sub-workgroups will be created in collaboration with local districts
- The **PACE** sub-workgroup meetings will commence on March 16th
- The first **Steering Committee meeting** is in the process of being scheduled
