

DSRIP Implementation Timeline and Key Benchmarks




Domain 4: PPS working in collaboration with community and diverse set of service providers to address statewide public health priorities; system improvements and increased quality of care will positively impact health outcomes of total population.

Midpoint Assessment

- PPS Provider 360 surveys completed by 9/30/16
- PPS Progress Narratives submitted 8/5/16
- PPS Primary Care Plan strategies submitted 8/31/16
- September-October 2016 on-site PPS visits by Independent Assessor (IA)
- November 10, 2016- PPS receive initial IA recommendations
- Two Public Comment periods for initial IA recommendations and for final IA recommendations
- Public meeting of IA recommendations to PAOP 1/3117 2/03/17
- Review and approval by Commissioner of DOH and CMS
- Mid Point PPS Action Plans March 2017
- April 2017 Starts Demonstration Year 3

Measurement Year 3 Critical Period for Performance


- Measurement Year 3 July 1, 2016-June 30, 2017
- \$902m in Achievement Value at stake for the MY3 measures to be paid out in DY3
- "Pay for Reporting" P4R phase transitioning down
- "Pay for Performance" P4P phase begins with DY2 Q4
- Performance payments to PPS are based upon claims and encounter data
- What is happening now in provider offices related to system transformation will impact both PPS performance and statewide performance

MCP Rosters of PPS Attributed Members

- MCP rosters of members by PPS are in development
- Requires a DEAA with the DOH
- Anticipate the end of November for the delivery of the Roster when there is updated Attribution run for all PPS, then MCP
- Need to identify who in each MCP would be the receiver of this file through SFTP

The DSRIP Dashboards have PPS Members who have opted out included in aggregate but not the drill down vs the MCP Member Rosters expected to include *all* current members and their currently attributed PPS name

Opt Out Mailings for Medicaid members

- Phase I of 510,000 Opt Out of data-sharing letters sent between 10/19/15 and 11/25/15 prior to the call center black out period for Open Enrollment.
- Phase II 4.9 million Opt Out letters sent between 2/22/16 and 3/15/2016.
- Phase III mailing 1.5 million Opt Out letters between 8/8/16 and 8/19/16. 1.2 million were new eligible and 300,000 new addresses for member whose mail was previously undeliverable.
- Maximus call center is currently in a black out period for mailing until February 2017. The program anticipates another mailing to take place March 2017 or soon thereafter.
- Requested Opt Outs as of 10/1/16 Approximately 165,000 or about 3%.



Call Center volume & trends

- More than 100,000 calls regarding DSRIP have been answered to date.
- Top 7 General Questions/Requests:
 - Why did I receive this letter?
 - What is DSRIP?
 - What does the PPS offer/what can they do to manage my care?
 - Do my benefits or doctors change?
 - Will I get penalized if I opt out?
 - Do I have to pay for this program?
 - Wants letter sent in their native language/translation request



Opt Out Translations
