Dear Administrator/Director of Nursing:

This letter provides information regarding your facility's Minimum Data Set (MDS) census data collection period for Medicaid reimbursement. The census will include ALL RESIDENTS regardless of payer source. The Department plans to utilize the January 29, 2020 census date to calculate the case mix adjustment for the July 1, 2020 rates.

NEW: Facilities will be able to reset their match status if a resident was selected in error or erroneously omitted. The *link* "click here to unmatched" will be displayed next to Record Status as shown below:



After your data has been accepted, the system generated acknowledgement of receipt message will state that you have an additional seven (7) calendar days in which to make corrections to the Payer, Dementia and BMI selections. Please ensure your corrections are done by December 31, 2020 in order to meet the certification deadline.
