


MLTC Statewide Enrollment





Conflict-Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) Activity as of April 1, 2016

- The CFEC is operational throughout the state and evaluations have occurred in all counties.
- Average call volume is 854 per day.
- 155 nurses are on staff to handle the volume.
- 71,776 evaluations conducted to date:
 - √97% approval rate
 - √3% denial rate

MLTC Update

- MLTC Policy 16.01: UAS-NY Assessment Requirements reiterated assessment requirements as previously provided in MLTC Policy documents, the UAS-NY Training Environment and Department-issued memos.
- MLTC Policy 16.02: Statutory Changes for Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Services (CDPAS)
 - Written as a result of Chapter 511 of the Laws of 2015, and impacts those who may work as a CDPAS personal assistant for an eligible participant.
 - Allows parents of adult children to be hired and work as a CDPAS personal assistant.
 - o Chapter 511 was effective April 1, 2016.

MLTC Update

- The State legislature recently passed legislation as part of the SFY 2016-17 budget extending the Nursing Home Transition and Diversion (NHTD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Waiver Transition process.
- The transition for TBI and NHTD waiver benefits into managed care will be delayed until January 1, 2018.



FIDA Update

- FIDA Marketing Guidance was updated to reflect reforms and finalized on March 22nd.
- Plans have reported many success stories on the positive experiences participants are having as a result of joining FIDA.
- A FIDA advertising campaign is underway; it is a multipronged approach involving digital, print, outdoor and radio advertisements. Digital component will be first to go live, with ads appearing on relevant websites and phone apps in late May.
- Plans should feel free to time their own outreach activities to maximize impact of FIDA publicity.
