

MLTC Update

- Since the last Policy and Planning meeting, the following policies have been released and posted on the MRT 90 website:

CFEEC Activity as of January 4, 2016

- The CFEEC is operational throughout the state and evaluations have occurred in all counties.
- Average call volume is 771 per day.
- 141 nurses are on staff to handle the volume.
- 49,516 evaluations conducted to date:
 - ✓97% approval rate
 - ✓ 3% denial rate



FIDA Update

- FIDA Reforms were released in December. The summary document and the revised IDT Policy are posted on the FIDA MRT 101 website at <u>https://www.health.ny.gov/health_care/medicaid/redesign/mrt_101.htm</u>
- DOH held a MRT stakeholder webinar on the FIDA Reforms on December 22, 2015, and over 350 people participated. The slides are available on the MRT 101 website.
- A FIDA workgroup met to discuss potential ideas for advertising.
- DOH and CMS will be hosting an educational training event on Wednesday, January 27, at CMS Regional Office. Continuing educations credits will be available. MetroPlus and Senior Whole Health's Medicaid Directors will be presenting on their best practices and experiences.

- DOH released a FAQ related to Nursing Facilities. This FAQ is also on the MRT 101 website.
- Value Based Payment Update NYSDOH has revised the deadline for FIDA Plans to submit their Alternative Payment Arrangements from 1/1/2016 to **4/1/2016**.
- FIDA Implementation calls are moving to biweekly calls.
- Reminder that the FIDA PNDS submissions are due tomorrow.
