**Hospital and Adult Care Facility Healthcare Evacuation Center (HEC) Training**

**Background:**

The Healthcare Facility Evacuation Center (HEC) is a tactical communications and coordination center that centralizes support to an ordered evacuation of hospitals, nursing homes, adult care facilities, and psychiatric hospitals. The HEC supports evacuating and sheltering in place (SiP) healthcare facilities with information, resources, and troubleshooting and the repatriation of healthcare facilities following an event.

**Goal:**

To provide adult care facilities and hospitals with an overview of the Healthcare Evacuation Center (HEC). This overview will include the roles and responsibilities of healthcare facilities as well as the roles of local, state and federal partners. Additionally, an overview of New York State Department of Health's patient tracking system will be provided.

**How to Register:**

LMS requires a separate registration distinct from a Health Commerce System (HCS) account. If you do not have a LMS account respond to the prompt, "Not Registered Yet? 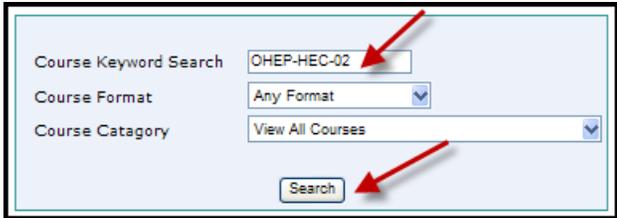
1. If you have a LMS Username and Password then login and proceed to Step 3. If you do not have a LMS Username and Password then proceed to Step 2.



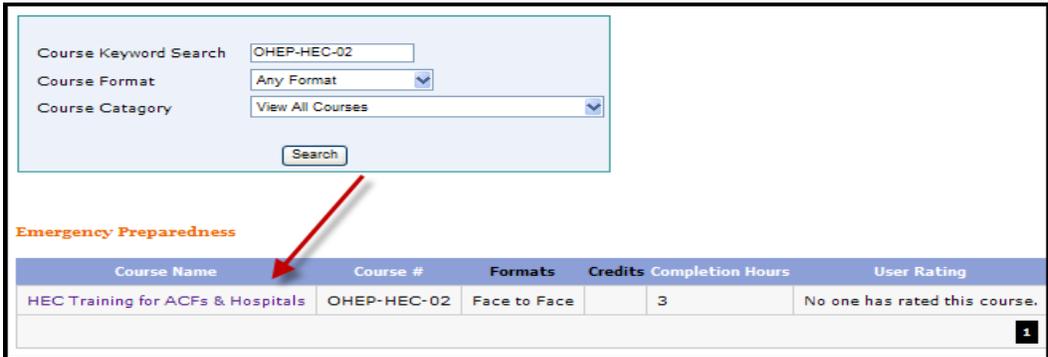
2. Select **CLICK HERE** to register and complete the registration form
  - Choose your own username & password
  - Fill in all required fields, denoted with an asterisk (\*)
  - Please include your organization's name in the first line of your work address
  - Birth year, while not required, is requested to help identify duplicate records
  - Please include your Agency Information. Hospitals should choose "Other - Hospital" and Adult Care Facilities should choose "Other-Adult Care Facilities" from drop down menu.
  - Click **Submit Your Registration**.

3. Now that you are logged into the LMS select **Course Catalog** from the navigation menu on the left side of the screen.
4. Enter course name **OHEP-HEC-02** and then click "Search"
