FUNCTIONAL REPORTING CENTER: Home Health care

DEFINITION

The provision of nursing care and professional and nonprofessional services to patients at their place of residence.

REPRESENTATIVE ACTIVITIES

Each of the following functions can be performed to patients outside the nursing home: nursing care, intravenous therapy, inhalation therapy, electrocardiology, physical therapy, occupational and recreational therapy, speech and hearing therapy, social services, dietary services, and house-keeping services.

RESPONSIBILITY CENTER WHERE NORMALLY RECORDED

3090, 6090      Home Health Care

RECLASSIFICATION

Reclassification may be required if revenues and/or expenses associated with activities assigned to this functional reporting center have been assigned to a responsibility center account or accounts other than accounts 3090 and 6090 and if the amount is significant.

STANDARD UNIT OF MEASURE: Number of Home Health Patient Visits

The number of home health patient visits shall be the number of home health patients visited at their place of residence by representatives of the home health program.

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FUNCTIONAL REPORTING CENTER: Home Health Care (Cont'd)

DATA SOURCE

The number of home health patient visits shall be the actual count obtained from Home Health Services.

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FUNCTIONAL REPORTING CENTER: Homemaker

DEFINITION

The provision of domestic services to patients at their place of residence.

REPRESENTATIVE ACTIVITIES

Each of the following functions can be performed under this program at the patient's residence: housekeeping, dietary, maintenance, laundry and linen, and patient education.

RESPONSIBILITY CENTER WHERE NORMALLY RECORDED

3110, 6110 Homemaker

RECLASSIFICATION

Reclassification may be required if revenues and/or expenses associated with activities assigned to this functional reporting center have been assigned to a responsibility center account or accounts other than accounts 3110 and 6110 and if the amount is significant.

STANDARD UNIT OF MEASURE: Number of Homemaker Visits

The number of homemaker visits shall be the number of homemaker patients visited at their place of residence by representatives of the homemaker program.

DATA SOURCE

The number of homemaker visits shall be the actual count obtained from homemaker services.
