Subject: Processing of January 2014 MDS
Census Collection – July 2014 Rates

Dear Administrator:

This is to formally advise you that new Medicaid rates for your residential health care facility have been promulgated and are now available on the Health Commerce System (HCS). The rates described herein are effective July 1, 2014 and are all-inclusive rates for health care services provided at your facility.

The formula on which these rates are based was promulgated in accordance with Article 28 of the Public Health law and Part 86 of the Commissioner's Administrative Rules and Regulations.

The rates may contain an adjustment to limit the impact for any facility that reported a case mix change of greater than plus or minus five percent from the previous case mix case mix. The allowable positive and negative adjustments establish a floor and ceiling decrease / increase for facilities. If a facility's reported case mix is below the floor, the facility's change is limited to no less than the floor. Conversely, if a facility's reported case mix is above the ceiling level, the facility was held to the ceiling increase as calculated for the individual facility.
