RE: Episodic Payment System for Certified Home Health Agencies - Updated Wage Index Factors and Revenue Code Rates

#### Dear Administrator:

In accordance with Section 3614.13 of the Public Health Law, the Episodic Payment System is scheduled to take effect April 1, 2012 for all Certified Home Health Agency patients age 18 and older.

On January 9, 2012, the Department provided detailed Billing Guidelines for the Episodic Payment System, together with preliminary regional Wage Index Factors and preliminary weighted average statewide rates to be associated with the Revenue Codes which will be utilized in the calculation of Low Utilization Payment Amounts and Outlier Payments.

The wage factors and average rates have now been finalized and are included as attachments to this letter. Wage factors are based on the most recent available Occupational Employment Statistics and utilization data from certified CHHA cost reports for 2010. Weighted average rates are based on the latest approved rates for CHHAs.
