### **Global Cap Overview**

#### • Remained under the cap for three consecutive years:

- o 2011-12: \$14 million;
- **2012-13:** \$2 million; and
- o 2013-14: \$39 million
- Through March 2014 total Medicaid enrollment reached 5.7 million; an increase of 446,451 enrollees over the prior year of which approximately 230,000 are attributed to the Affordable Care Act.



## 2014-15 Global Cap Projections

• The Global Spending Cap is projected to grow \$540 million in 2014-15; highlights include:

Price (+\$972 million)	<ul> <li>\$432M (4.9%) for mainstream managed care</li> <li>\$253M (7%) for long term managed care (includes wage parity)</li> <li>\$162M for Nursing Homes (includes July 2013 &amp; January 2014 case mix; cash receipts assessment reconciliation)</li> <li>\$125M for various FFS rate packages</li> </ul>	
Utilization (+\$343 million)	<ul> <li>annualization of FY 2014 net enrollment growth (446,451 recipients);</li> <li>new enrollment for FY 2015, including enrollment under the NYSoH Exchange</li> </ul>	
MRT/One-Timers/Other (-\$775 million)	<ul> <li>\$1.1B for ACA enhanced FFP</li> <li>\$285M in lower MH Stabilization funds; offset by</li> <li>\$300M for Financial Plan relief</li> <li>\$302M for 2% ATB restoration</li> </ul>	



## Preliminary results through June 2014

Preliminary Medicaid expenditures through June 2014 are \$10 million or
 0.2% below projections.

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# Article VII Highlights

- Extends Global Cap through March 2016 and includes expanded reporting requirements.
- Repeals 2% Across the Board payment reduction effective April 1, 2014.
  - > Provides flexibility in restoring alternate savings measures.
- Creates a Global Cap Dividend payment.
- Dedicates \$110 million to successfully transform the Behavioral Health Systems as the State transitions to Managed Care.
- Authorizes the State to create a Basic Health Program (BHP).
