Passive Enrollment Schedule

July 1:

2,599 individuals were enrolled.

August 1:

- 60 day letter was sent May 26, 2015.
- 30 day letter was sent June 24, 2015.
- 4,211 individuals are set to be passively enrolled.

September 1:

- 60 day letter was sent June 23, 2015.
- 30 day letter will be sent July 23, 2015.
- 1,721 are set to be passively enrolled.



FIDA Update

Outreach and Education Event for Providers

- On **June 18**th, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and DOH convened a roundtable for plans and providers.
- Approximately 150 people participated.
- The event included an overview and update of FIDA by DOH and CMS. In addition, a
 panel of FIDA Plan Medical Directors highlighted the benefits of FIDA and their best
 practices and experiences.
- An open discussion followed to facilitate collaboration between providers and plans.
 Themes of issues discussed: IDT coordination with Nursing Homes and provider training flexibility.




FIDA Update


- Since the last Policy and Planning meeting, the following has occurred:

MLTC Update

- CMS approved the remaining counties for transition: Allegany, Clinton, Franklin, Jefferson, Lewis, and St. Lawrence.
- The "Front Door" closed for those new to community-based long term care (CBLTC) services on July 3, 2015.
- As of July 6, 2015, new users in these counties will go to NY Medicaid Choice for education and referral to the Conflict Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) for evaluation.



CFEEC Activity as of July 8, 2015

- The CFEC is operational throughout the state.
- Letters were sent to the Local Department of Social Services Commissioners for the remaining six counties notifying them of the change.
- Average call volume is 665 690 per day.
- 144 nurses are on staff to handle the volume, more will be added as needed.
- Evaluations conducted to date:
 - 98% approval rate
 - 2% denial rate
