Quality

- Quality measurement of health plans (QARR)
 - Current: Medicaid, CHPlus, special needs plans, commercial managed care, MLTC
 - Proposed: qualified health plans, FIDA, behavioral health, HARP, BHO, and DISCOs

DSRIP

Lead in measure specifications, development and reporting



Quality (continued)

- Quality measurement of hospitals
 - Cardiac
 - Stroke care
 - HAI
 - Soon: PPRs, PPCs
- Long term care quality
 - Nursing home quality measures
 - Nursing home quality initiative
 - Home care quality measures



Patient Safety

Office based surgery

- Requires reporting of adverse events from over 1000 accredited OBS practices
- 600 AEs per year under-reported

Sepsis

- Three prong approach:
- Structure requirement of a sepsis protocol 1/1/14
- Process/Outcome data collection started, to measure adherence to protocols and in the future, risk adjusted mortality



Data Systems

All Payer Database

- Intake system in production for QHPs
- RFP in development for data warehousing and analytics
- Regulation in development

SPARCS

- Inpatient, ER, ambulatory surgery data, outpatient data
- Vital Statistics
 - Births, death, fetal deaths
- Medicaid
 - Significant role in data needs related to Medicaid including evaluating utilization, rate setting and quality

Transparency

Open.data.ny

- Portal with over 200 data sets
- Open to the public
- De-identified data

Health Profiles

- Redesigning the Health Profiles on the DOH website
- Simple, user-friendly application for consumers
- Began with hospitals in September 2014
- Home care, nursing home care in development
- Managed care information in the future

Health Information Technology

Lead on the SHIN-NY

- Network of networks to connect all EHRs in NYS.
- Regional Health Information Organizations (RHIOs) connect local EHRs together
- Public input into the governance
- HCRA funded, Medicaid funded
- Essential component for:
 - Meaningful Use
 - DSRIP



Evaluation

- Lead on evaluation of Medicaid
 - DSRIP evaluation plan
- Conduct and support health services research across the multiple DOH data sets

 Work closely with universities, consultants, think tanks on using DOH data effectively
