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Federal Approval Update

- Working with CMS on weekly basis
 - CMS has committed to work with NYS to achieve end of March waiver approval
 - Key outstanding issues include:
 - □ Conflict Free Care Management (NYS submitted proposal to CMS for review)
 - □ Compliance with HCBS settings rule (where recipient lives and where service is delivered)
 - Special terms and conditions
 - Premium approvals

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NYC Readiness Review Timeline Update

- □ HARP/ Mainstream Desk Audit deliverables due on 3/9/15
 - □ State Policy Change: HIV/SNPs meeting HARP designation criteria now allowed to manage HCBS services for HARP eligibles
 - Specific HIV/ SNP readiness requirements TBD
- ☐ Target timeframe for NYC On-site reviews April- May 2015
- □ Readiness Reviews complete June 2015

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HCBS Designation Update

- □ 170 NYC providers applied for designation to provide the HCBS
- Most providers applied for multiple HCBS
- □ Applications were reviewed by DOH, OMH, OASAS and NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
- □ A list with designated NYC providers will be released shortly
- □ NYS is developing an oversight process for HCBS providers

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Billing Manual Update

- □ State working through comments received from Plans
- □ Updated billing manual scheduled for release end of February
- □ State is reviewing BH regulatory requirements for possible modification in a Managed Care environment
