Children's Design Recap

- Phase I: Enrollment of Children into Health Home (January 2016)
- Phase II: Implementation of six new State Plan services (July 2016)
- Phase III: Transition of existing BH Medicaid services, six new State Plan services, new array of HCBS benefits and foster care population to MMC (NYC + LI January 2017, ROS July 2017)
- Phase IV: Discontinuance of five children's 1915c Waivers (late 2017)
- Phase V: Expansion of target population to include children meeting Level of Need criteria (January/July 2018)



Phase I: Update Health Home Serving Children

- On June 15, 2015 State contingently designated 16 Health Homes to serve children
 - ✓ List of designated Health Homes, service area by county and primary contact at:
http://www.health.ny.gov/health_care/medicaid/program/medicaid_health_homes/docs/hh_children_designations.pdf
- The contingencies fell into five broad categories of network sufficiency related to existing OMH TCM providers, voluntary foster care agencies who will be the HH care managers for children enrolled in HH and waiver care managers; billing readiness; clarification on approach to delivering Health Home core services to children; Health Home HIT requirements, completion of administrative requirements (DEAA, BAAs, and NPI/MMIS#s if required)
 - ✓ 12 Existing Health Homes expanded their service area to serve children
 - ✓ 4 are “new” Health Homes Serving Children, one of which is a collaboration among four existing Health Homes
 - ✓ There are at least two Health Homes Serving Children (HHSC) in every county of the State



Next Steps for Contingently Designated HHSC

- June 24, 2015 Webinar provided guidance to HHSC regarding accepting designation and agreement to address contingencies and completing administrative/readiness requirements
- September 24, 2015 Webinar provided detailed update summarizing the readiness of each Health Home

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Process for Verifying Contingently Designated Health Homes Have Satisfied Contingencies and Readiness Requirements

- The Department has reached out to select Health Homes to schedule meetings to discuss status of readiness activities and projected timelines for satisfying contingencies
- Health Homes that have satisfied all the items on the check list will receive a letter from Department indicating they have satisfied their contingencies and are ready to enroll children in Health Homes
 - “New” Health Homes with a 12/15/16 HIT due date that have satisfied all other contingencies will receive a letter indicating they may enroll children and will be expected to meet the 12/15/16 HIT technology requirements
 - Department is working to verify that all OMH TCM providers that will convert to Health Home have a BAA with at least one Health Home – Department may reach out to select Health Homes to help ensure this requirement is met to ensure smooth transition to Health Homes



Status of State Plan Amendment for HHSC

- Since the Fall of last year, State has had many discussions with CMS and SAMHSA to amend State Plan to serve children in Health Home
- SPA has four primary elements:
 - Use of CANS-NY Assessment – modified for HHSC – will be used to determine Health Home rate (High, Medium, Low structure)
 - Referral, rather than assignment list, process for enrollment (MAPP)
 - Conversion of OMH TCM providers to Health Home
 - Modifications to Health Home eligibility criteria for children: Complex Trauma and Serious Emotional Disturbance (Child companion to adult SMI), each as single qualifying conditions for Health Home eligibility
- CMS and SAMHSA very supportive of complex trauma as chronic condition and children's Health Home design – next discussion being scheduled for end of October



Other HHSC Design Updates and Information

- Next Design, Readiness/Implementation Webinar targeted for end of October
- The State is assessing the impact of the status of the readiness of contingently designated Health Homes and challenges standing up Phase I of MAPP may have on the January 1, 2015 date for beginning to enroll children in Health Homes
- Earlier this Summer State inquired if Plans would like an additional briefing/ information regarding design of Health Home model for children
- Would Plans like the State to Hold Webinar to Provide Overview of Model? Who should target audience be? Hampton Inn Group? Plan Medical Directors?

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Status of SPA and Children's 1115 Amendment

SPA for 6 New Plan Services

- Preliminary discussions with CMS have resulted in finely tuned draft amendment
- Regulatory development for Plan Services
- Submission to CMS requires fiscal - State team working with DOH rate setting and Mercer to develop fiscal
- Still on target for July 1, 2016 approval

1115 Amendment

- Draft received in August 2015 from Mercer
- Finalizing 1115 by December 31, 2015
- Guides Plan Model Contract revisions



Children's SPA Provider Manual

- Feedback from Stakeholders
- Evidence Based Practice Designation Process
- Match to final SPA
- Manual Revisions



Children's SPA Provider Designation

- Licensed, certified and/or designated by partner agencies
- Regulatory revisions for providers to have SPA authority for other service delivery
- Medicaid Provider Enrollment Review
- Assistance for Non-Medicaid Providers
- Transition to Managed Care in 2017



Children's HCBS Provider Designation

- Anticipate announcement & application in late 2015
- Grandfathering existing children's HCBS providers
- Apply for expanded service delivery
- New HCBS capacity – apply for new service designation



Plan RFQ & Readiness Review Process

- RFQ request to Plans in early 2016
- Outline overall vision and expectations for children's services (behavioral health, HCBS, transition of Foster Care population to Managed Care)
- Request written documents in addition to those submitted in adult process (avoid duplication of efforts)
- In-person readiness reviews – Fall 2016

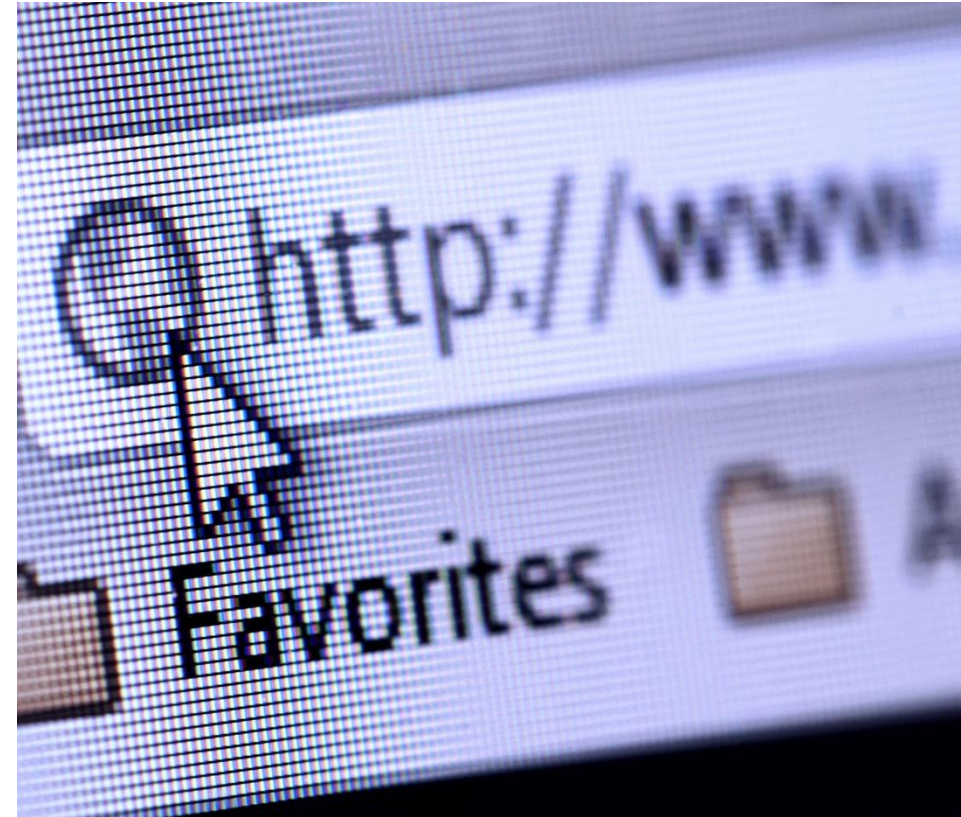
