

Long Term Care Forum

- On Tuesday, September 29, 2015, OHIP hosted a Long Term Care Forum on the future of MLTC and FIDA.
- 530 stakeholders participated in-person or by telephone.

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As of October 1:

- ✓ 9,065 are currently enrolled
- ✓ Of which 2,887 individuals were passively enrolled on October 1, 2015
- ✓ 2,777 IDT meetings have occurred

- DOH and CMS made the following changes to the Provider Training requirements. Additional changes may be forthcoming based on the LTC Forum.
- If a provider is in network, provider must take the FIDA Overview Training with the following exceptions:
 - > Anesthesiology
 - Pathology subspecialties
 - > Sports Medicine
 - Radiology subspecialties
 - > DME
 - Emergency

- Providers on the IDT are required to take the five trainings
 - FIDA Overview
 - Cultural Competency
 - Behavioral Health
 - Disability
 - Recovery and Wellness

MLTC Update
