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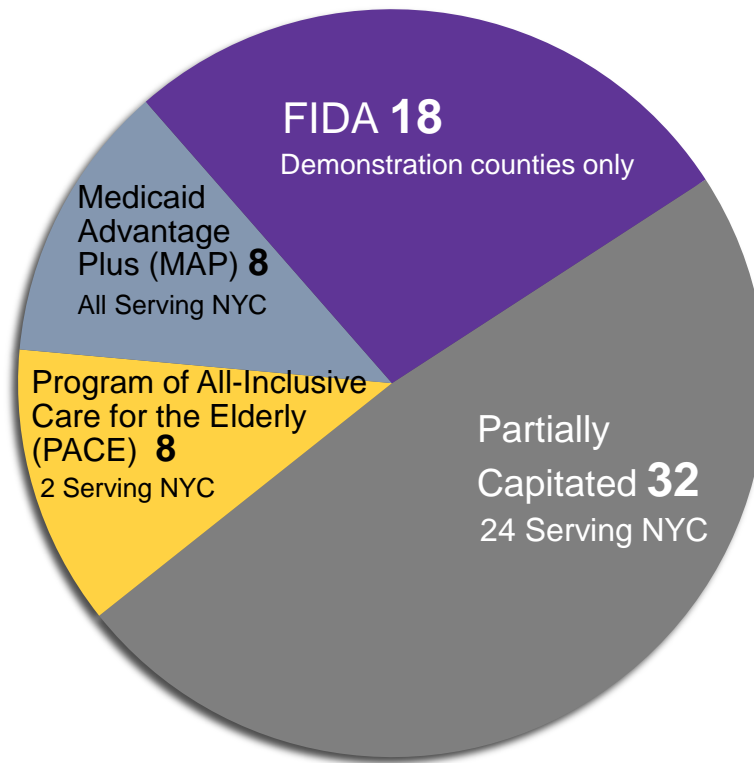

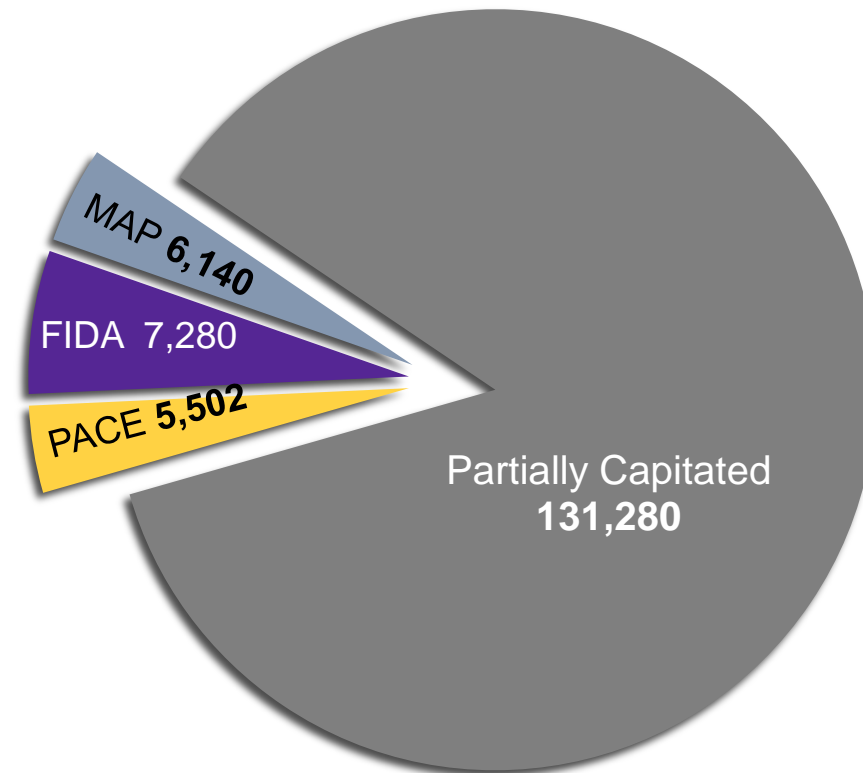
MLTC Statewide Enrollment – September 2015*

FIDA Update

As of October 1:

- ✓ 9,065 are currently enrolled
- ✓ Of which 2,887 individuals were passively enrolled on October 1, 2015
- ✓ 2,777 IDT meetings have occurred

FIDA Update

- DOH and CMS made the following changes to the Provider Training requirements. Additional changes may be forthcoming based on the LTC Forum.
- If a provider is in network, provider must take the FIDA Overview Training with the following exceptions:

- *Anesthesiology*
- *Pathology subspecialties*
- *Sports Medicine*
- *Radiology subspecialties*
- *DME*
- *Emergency Medicine*

- *Critical Care Medicine*
- *Environmental Supports*
- *Home Delivered Meals*
- *Laboratory*
- *Genetics*
- *Pediatrics*

- *Emergency Transportation (Ambulance)*
- *Non Emergency Transportation*
- *Hearing Aid Dispenser*
- *PERS (Personal Emergency Response)*

- Providers on the IDT are required to take the five trainings
 - FIDA Overview
 - Cultural Competency
 - Behavioral Health
 - Disability
 - Recovery and Wellness



FIDA Update

- **Since the last Policy and Planning meeting, the following has occurred:**
 - DOH and CMS hosted FIDA provider events on September 17 and 30th.
 - The Medical Directors from AlphaCare Signature FIDA Plan and VNSNY Choice FIDA Complete discussed best practices and experiences.
 - A FIDA presentation was given to the Medical Society of the State of New York LTC subcommittee.

MLTC Update

Since the last Policy and Planning meeting, the following has occurred:

- A survey was sent to ascertain compliance with MLTC Policy 14.08: Paying for Live-In 24 Hour Care for Personal Care Services and Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Services.
- DOH held a Nursing Home Transition and Diversion (NHTD) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) waiver transition to managed care subcommittee meeting on October 6, 2015.
