New York has the 6th longest ER wait time in the country! Lack of nursing home capacity contributes to delays in hospital discharges and ER back-ups.



Access to Quality Care is at Risk!

When nursing homes struggle to hire and retain direct care staff, nursing home beds, units and *sometimes entire homes* have to close. This reduces access to care.

- 3,500 nursing home beds are closed
- 7,200 beds offline due to staffing shortages
- 72,000 beds in financial distress
- 32 nursing homes have closed since 2014

To ensure access to high-quality nursing home care in **your community, New York must increase nursing home Medicaid rates to match the cost of care!**
