Dowdell’s involvement with the Buffalo Society of Artists and the Interior Design Association of WNY demonstrates her commitment to the arts community.

Another member of the “Quartet” showing is Cole Pawlowski, a young and emerging artist who holds degrees in education and psychology from the State University of New York at Buffalo. His work has hung on the walls of prestigious institutions such as the Hallwalls Contemporary Art Center, University of Buffalo Art Galleries, and the newly reopened Buffalo AKG Art Museum. The fourth member to round out the “Quartet” is Clarence native, Richard Rockford, who brings a wealth of experience to the exhibition. With a background in antiques and a transition to art, Rockford’s work showcases innovative trends, graphic arts, wood printing type, Native American arts, industrial antiques, folk art, and found object art. Among his many accomplishments, Rockford crafted a line of mirrors with aesthetic borders and frames that previously earned recognition at the American Craft Council’s prime Baltimore wholesale market.
