In November 2020 and May 2021, the Department of Health ("Department") issued Health Advisories related to in-house beauty salons and day programs for non-residents, detailing requirements for providing these services. As the COVID-19 positivity rate has decreased since these Health Advisories were issued, the Department will not issue a new Health Advisory but instead will require the adult care facility who wishes to re-open its beauty salon and/or day program for non-residents to their full capacities to:

- 1. Draft appropriate policies and procedures to ensure that infection prevention and control practices are paramount, including physical distancing and environmental cleaning.
- 2. Monitor community COVID-19 infection rates to drive decision-making and how to maintain residents' safety.
- 3. Ensure that policies and procedures are respectful and reflective of the residents' decisions and individual rights.
- 4. Continue to track residents' and employees' vaccination statuses to ensure health and safety and maintain regulatory compliance.
- 5. Report to the appropriate regional office adult care facility program team its decisions related to these two important services.

Please remain vigilant against COVID-19 and its variants to preserve the health and safety of our vulnerable residents and our precious human resources.
