

Most Social Security (including SSDI) and Railroad Retirement recipients who are not typically required to file a tax return do not need to take action.

The IRS will use the information from Forms SSA-1099 and RRB-1099 to generate the payment.

Recipients will receive \$1,200 payments automatically as a direct deposit or by mail, just as they would normally receive their benefits.

People in this group who have qualifying children under age 17 can visit IRS.gov and use the "Non-filers: Enter Payment Info Here" tool to claim the \$500 payment per child. Act soon!



The IRS will mail a letter to the individual's last known address within 15 days after the payment is issued.
