



Economic Impact Payments

for Social Security (including SSDI) and
Railroad Retirement recipients

Most Social Security (including SSDI) and Railroad Retirement recipients who are not typically required to file a tax return do not need to take action.

The IRS will use the information from Forms SSA-1099 and RRB-1099 to generate the payment.

Recipients will receive \$1,200 payments automatically as a direct deposit or by mail, just as they would normally receive their benefits.

People in this group who have qualifying children under age 17 can visit [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov) and use the *"Non-filers: Enter Payment Info Here"* tool to claim the \$500 payment per child. Act soon!



The IRS will mail a letter to the individual's last known address within 15 days after the payment is issued.
