

 - And more!




RBHN Consortium

Highlights

- Funding obtained through the FCC's HCF (Healthcare Connect Fund) Program
- Eligible facilities receive 65% subsidy on eligible broadband services and equipment
- \$11.4 million in committed funds for consortium members since 2015

Eligible Facilities

- Must be non-profit
- Eligible facilities types include Rural Health Clinics, Hospitals, FQHCs, Health Departments, Skilled Nursing Facilities, Teaching Hospitals, Admin Offices, Data Centers
