Each year, the resident-led donation drive works to increase the number of students who are helped and the amount they receive. Current recipients of the award are eligible for all four years of their undergraduate education.

The generosity that he and the other residents demonstrate through the Academic Achievement Awards means a great deal to our hardworking employees and their families."

Dr. Pasciuti concluded, "These employees take care of us and this Academic Achievement program enables us to help them and their children. It's a way of showing the next generation – our future leaders – that we appreciate them and want to help them further their education."
