**DANIEL REINGOLD, PRESIDENT AND CEO OF RIVERSPRING HEALTH,
AWARDED THE LEADINGAGE AWARD OF HONOR,
THE FIELD OF AGING'S HIGHEST ACHIEVEMENT**

(RIVERDALE, NY – October 28, 2018) – Daniel Reingold, President and CEO of RiverSpring Health, was recognized by the senior healthcare field's highest award – the Award of Honor – by LeadingAge on Sunday, October 28th, at the LeadingAge Annual Conference and Expo in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Reingold, internationally recognized as a visionary and leader in the field of aging, is most well known for transforming the lives of older adults through innovative programs that focus on maximizing quality of life, including:

- Creating the nation's first sexual expression policy in long-term care
- Co-founding the Weinberg Center for Elder Justice, the nation's first elder abuse shelter
- Starting the HOPE (Healthcare Offers Permanent Employment) program for non-diploma bound high school students
- Reducing prescription medication intake of Hebrew Home residents by making medical cannabis accessible to them

Reingold has become a highly visible advocate for older adults, having testified before the U.S. Senate Special Committee on Aging and attending the 2015 White House Conference on Aging.
