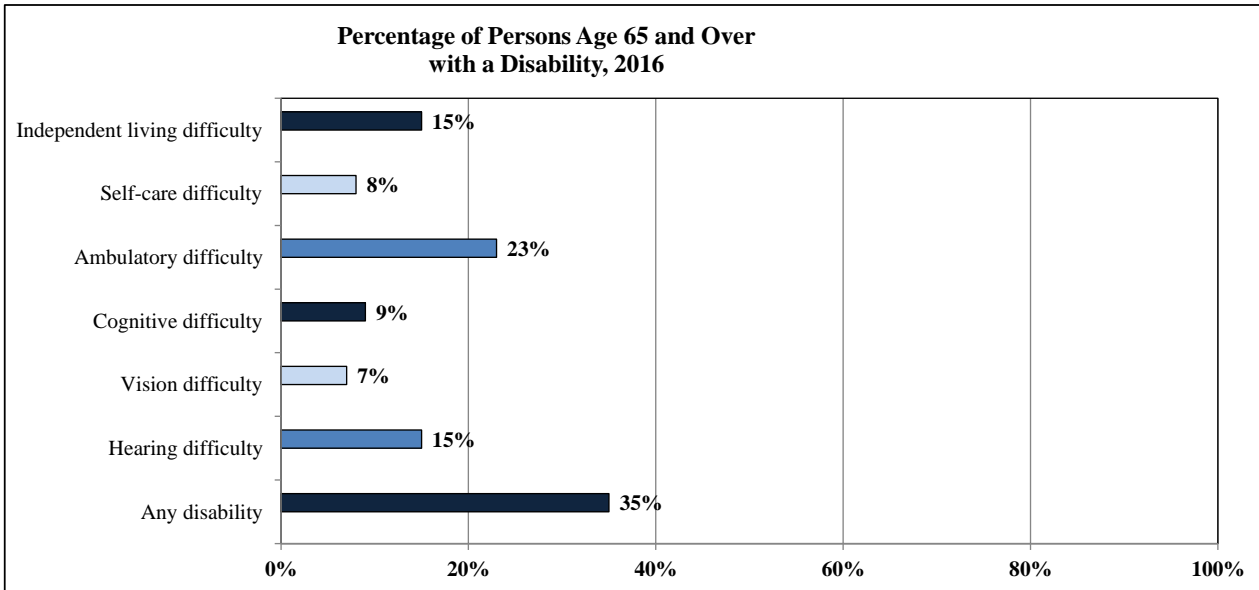


Figure 9 shows a chart of the percentage of older persons with disabilities. Among people age 65 and over, 35% have at least one disability. Other disabilities range from 7% with a vision difficulty to 23% with an ambulatory difficulty.
