**WHAT:** The Osborn hosted a Candidates Forum for the Rye, Rye City and Port Chester Chapter of the [League of Women Voters](#) with Keith Cunningham (R) and Jamie Jensen (D) - two political candidates running for Rye City Council, and Josh Nathan (D) – an incumbent running for re-election. Each candidate gave a 2-min opening statement and then addressed questions from the moderator and attendees. The forum was open to residents of The Osborn and community members which included a discussion on key issues facing Rye, NY.
