## **EPISCOPAL SENIORLIFE COMMUNITIES DONATES OVER 1,700 LBS. OF FOOD TO PEOPLE'S PANTRY OF ROCHESTER**

Staff from Episcopal SeniorLife Communities (ESLC) donated more than 1,700 pounds of food and personal care items to the People's Pantry of Rochester. Items were collected over the last several weeks in preparation for the annual pick up. The main campus of ESLC, located at 505 Mt. Hope Avenue, and the Pantry are both located in the City of Rochester, so there is a natural partnership between both organizations. The Pantry has expanded its reach and serves 26 zip codes throughout the surrounding area. This is the 16<sup>th</sup> year of the effort.
